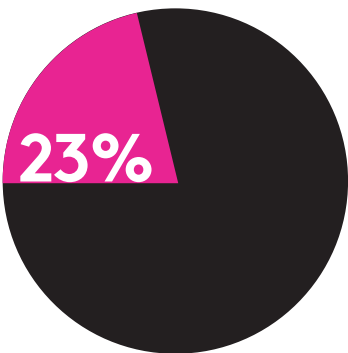

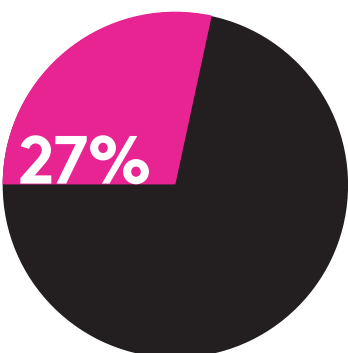

## Gender Pay Gap 2023

Among the 10 top artists in the International Art Ranking are 9 fathers with a total of 32 children.  
Only 3 of the 10 top artists are mothers. They each have 1 child.
